Proposed speed reduction measures on Westbury Avenue, N22

Dear Resident or Business,

Following requests from the local community, I am pleased to inform you that as part of our Road Danger Reduction Programme, we are proposing to introduce speed-reducing measures and a zebra crossing on Westbury Avenue. These measures aim to lower vehicle speeds, improve pedestrian accessibility and enhance road safety for all road users.

Details of the proposal are listed below and set out on the plan overleaf:

- Introduce a raised zebra crossing on Westbury Avenue, between Mark Road and Crawley Road, including associated lighting equipment and road markings.
- Introduce a speed hump outside 103/105 Westbury Avenue.
- Provide buff coloured high skid resistant surface treatment, on the approach to the zebra crossing.
- Provide 'Bend Ahead' warning signage.
- Remove traffic island outside 166 Westbury Avenue.
- Relocate traffic island from outside 160 to near 162 Westbury Avenue.

This letter marks the start of a public consultation, during which we welcome your views on the proposed measures. If you have objections; please also give reasons for these so that we can fully understand any issues and concerns.
