Background

5.1 An application for a new Premises Licence, by Mr Veysel Yavuz in respect of Gokyuzu Restaurant, 26-27 Grand parade, Green Lanes, London N4 1LG under the Licensing Act 2003.

To whom it may concern, I am writing to you as resident landlord of 25 A & B Grand Parade, N4 1LG

I am writing regarding the applications placed by Mr Vaysel Yavuz in order that he be licensed to serve alcohol and late night refreshments from the newly extended Gokyuzu restaurant on Grand Parade.

Please accept this letter as formal objection to the applications placed, in relation to the prevention of public nuisance and public safety.

The rear of the restaurant property adjoins our property, even before the restaurants extension the noise levels from staff at the back of the restaurant and patrons exiting the front of the restaurant have been intolerable to my tenants and myself.

My tenants and I have suffered greatly due to shouting, arguments and general commercial noise at unacceptable times of the early hours of the morning. We feel that the extension of the restaurant and the outdoor portion of the restaurant will only multiply the noise levels we have had to deal with for a number of years not to mention rendering parts of our property uninhabitable if people are allowed to smoke in appointed outdoor area. Please note this area is less than 5 meters away from our closest inhabited tenement.

We understand Mr Yavuz has operated a family restaurant from the adjoining location for a number of years, we have no objection to Mr Yavuz continuing his business inside the proposed buildings, our objections are based upon the proposed outdoor portion of the restaurant which Mr Yavuz has already advertised as a 140 Seat outdoor smoking area.

We would ask that a condition of the granting of this license would be that the outdoor portion of the restaurant be restricted to the hours set forth within the UK noise abatement act 1960 and not the proposed time of 02:00 AM as applied for by Mr Yavuz.

The tenants at the rear of my property work in the food industry and begin work at 5:00 AM, to have disruption and noise continuing till 02:00 would be completely unacceptable and cause considerable hardship and suffering, not to mention the financial losses that myself and my partner would incur eventually as a result of our tenants having to leave the property once rendered uninhabitable by the restaurant.

Having searched the local planning applications extensively I have been unable to find an application by Mr Yavuz for permission to demolish the existing structures to construct the outdoor portion of the restaurant. Had a planning application been authorised and advertised in the proper manner, I would have also placed formal objections with the local planning authorities.

Based upon the evidence we have presented we would ask that our objections be acknowledged and considered during the review process of the issuing of the licenses applied for. Should the license be granted to allow Mr Yavuz to conduct business in the outdoor portion of the restaurant outside of the hours set forth in the UK noise abatement act 1960, my partner and I shall be seeking legal counsel to recover any costs losses incurred as a result of this decision.
