

I would like to confirm that I have considered the above proposal with regard to the prevention of public nuisance on behalf of the Enforcement Response (Noise) Team & would like to make representations to the Application.

I have inspected the premises in person and I had a discussion with applicant during my visit.

The operating schedule does not address the prevention of public nuisance but the applicant has agreed to:

- Take measures to control airborne entertainment noise
- Prevent structure borne noise or vibrations from entertainment
- Noise generated by patrons in external areas of the premises e.g. beer garden

The proposed operating hours are appropriate for the main restaurant area. The cessation of licensable activities at 23:30.

The external or annexed seating areas will be unavailable to patrons at 22:30 or earlier. The noise caused by patrons seated or occupying the external seating areas is likely to be detrimental to the residential amenity. The applicant has agreed to advice all patrons to move indoors no later than 22:30.

Supporting Information







A warning letter was served on Sandero Restaurant on 6 June 2010 in relation to noise nuisance caused by loud music.

If the sub-committee were to grant this application then we would recommend the following alterations/conditions to the operating schedule:

Operating hours

That the premises closes no later than 23:30 from Sunday to Thursday, and regulated entertainment shall cease at 23:00 for the inside of the premises and 2230 for the outside area.

Prevention of nuisance from noise / vibration

All doors and windows will remain closed during the licensed regulated entertainment activities or in any event after 11pm. The entrance door will be fitted with a self-closing device and staff required to ensure that it is not propped open. A member of staff shall be made responsible to ensure the door is opened for as brief a period as possible. Entry to the premises will be restricted to front entrance door on St Anns Road, N15, only, whilst the premises is being used for regulated entertainment licensed activity

Entrance/exit from the premises whilst regulated entertainment licensable activities are ongoing shall be via a lobbied door to minimise noise breakout.

The regulated entertainment licensable activity shall conclude 30 minutes before the premises is due to close to prevent excessive noise breakout as the premises empties

Other doors e.g. fire doors

The doors that separate the kitchen and the external seating areas will remain closed while regulated entertainment is being operated.

Structure borne noise

All speakers are mounted on anti-vibration mountings to prevent vibration transmission of sound energy to adjoining properties

Sound limits

The licensee shall ensure that no music played in the licensed premises is audible at or within the site boundary of any residential property

All regulated entertainment amplified activity will utilise the in-house amplification system, the maximum output of which is controlled by the duty manager

The level of amplified regulated entertainment shall be controlled by means of limiting device set at a level which upon request may be agreed with the licensing authority

Outside Areas

No music other than background music will be played in external or annexed seating areas of the premises. Any music played in external areas shall cease at 22:30 every day.

No form of loudspeaker or sound amplification equipment is to be sited on or near the exterior premises or in or near any foyer, doorway, window or opening to the premises. The applicant has agreed not to play music in the external seating areas.

Signs shall be displayed in the external areas/on the frontage requesting patrons to recognise the residential nature of the area and conduct their behaviour accordingly. The management must reserve the right to ask patrons to move inside the premises or leave if it is felt that they could be disturbing neighbours

Only patrons seated at tables will be permitted in the beer garden or the side/external seating areas.

The beer garden/external/side seating area will be closed and patrons requested to come inside the main structure of the premises at 22:30 every day of the week.

Deliveries and collections.

Deliveries and collections associated with the premises will be arranged between the hours 08:00 and 19:00, Monday –Friday, so as to minimise the disturbance caused to the neighbours

Glasses will be collected from the beer garden area at the beginning of the day rather than at closing time when neighbours in close proximity might be unduly disturbed

Empty bottles and non-degradable refuse will remain in the premises at the end of trading hours and taken out to the refuse point at the start of the working day rather than at the end of trading when neighbours might be unduly disturbed

Plant and machinery

All plant and machinery is correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that it is operating efficiently and with minimal disturbance to neighbours arising from noise

Dealing with complaints

A complaints book will be held on the premises to record details of any complaints received from neighbours. The information is to include, where disclosed, the complainant's name, location, date time and subsequent remedial action undertaken. This record must be made available at all times for inspection by council officers

Patrons entering/exiting premises.

There will be no queuing outside the premises.

Where people queue to enter the premises a licensed door supervisor shall supervise and ensure the potential patrons behave in an acceptable manner

Signs should be displayed requesting patrons to respect the neighbours and behave in a courteous manner

Prevention of nuisance from litter

Adequate receptacles for use by patrons will be provided in the local vicinity. The positioning of the receptacles will be agreed with the licensing officer

Prevention of Nuisance from Odour

All ventilation and extraction systems shall be correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that it is operating efficiently and with minimal disturbance to neighbours arising from odour
