

5. REPORT

Background

5.1 An application for a new Premises Licence, by Eko Mar Wood Green Ltd in respect of Eko Mar, 37 Station Road, Wood Green, London N22 6XB under the Licensing Act 2003.

5.2 Details of the application being sought under a new Premises Licence APP1

Supply of Alcohol:

Sunday to Thursday

0800 to 0000

Friday & Saturday

0800 to 0200

Opening Hours:

The premises may be open for non-licensable activities without limit.

General-all four licensing objectives

The Licensee, that is the person in whose name the premises licence is issued, shall ensure that at all times when the premises is used for any licensable activity, there are sufficient competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder. The Licensee shall ensure that all staff will undertake training in their responsibilities in relation to the sale of alcohol, particularly with regard to drunkenness and underage persons. Records will be kept of training and refresher training.

5.3 Crime and Disorder

Any incidents of a criminal nature that may occur on the premises will be reported to the Police. Toilets shall be checked an average of two hourly while the premises are open to the public to deter the use of drugs. Details of checks shall be documented and made available to Police on request.

The licensee will install comprehensive CCTV coverage at the premises and it is operated and maintained at the premises.

The CCTV system shall conform to the following points:

1. Cameras must be sited to observe the entrance and exit doors both inside and outside.
2. Cameras on the entrances must capture full frame shots of the heads and shoulders of all people entering the premises, i.e. capable of identification.
3. Cameras viewing till areas must capture frames not less than 50% of the screen,
4. Cameras overlooking floor areas should be wide angled to give an overview of the premises.
5. Be capable of visually confirming the nature of the crime committed.
6. Provide a linked record of the date, time and place of any image.

7. Provide good quality images—colour during opening times.
8. Operate under existing light levels within and outside the premises.
9. Have the recording device located in a secure area or locked cabinet.
10. Have a monitor to review images and recorded picture quality.
11. Be regularly maintained to ensure continuous quality of image capture retention.
12. Have signage displayed in the customer area to advise that CCTV is in operation.
13. Digital images must be kept for 31 days.
14. Police will have access to images at any reasonable time.
15. The equipment must have a suitable export method, e.g. CD/DVD writer so that the police can make an evidential copy of the data they require. This data should be in the native file format, to ensure that no image quality is lost when making the copy, if this format is non-standard (i.e. manufacturer proprietary) then the manufacturer should supply the replay software to ensure that the video on the CD can be replayed by the police on a standard computer. Copies must be made available to Police on request.

5.4 Public Safety

Appropriate fire safety procedures will be in place including fire extinguishers (Foam, H₂O and CO₂), fire blankets, internally illuminated fire exit signs, numerous smoke detectors and emergency lighting (see plan for details of locations). All appliances will be inspected annually.

All emergency exits will be kept free from obstruction at all times.

5.5 Public Nuisance

All customers will be asked to leave quietly.

Clear and legible notices will be prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly and have regard to the neighbours.

5.6 Child Protection

Licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 21 for photographic ID such as proof of age cards, the Connexions card, and Citizen Card, photographic driving licence or passport, an official identity card issued by HM Forces or by an EU country, bearing the photograph and date of birth of bearer.

The Challenge 21 logo and posters will be displayed at the premises.

All staff will be trained for UNDERAGE SALES PREVENTION regularly.

A register of refused sales shall be kept and maintained on the premises.

The operating schedule does not address the prevention of public nuisance from:

- Structure borne noise or machinery noise
- Noise generated from deliveries
- Noise from plant and machinery
- Light nuisance
- Litter nuisance

Supporting Information

Having checked local noise nuisance complaints for the area, from noise from other licensed premises (public house) and delivery noise to superstores behind premises. I have made further recommendations.

Deliveries and collections.

Deliveries and collections associated with the premises will be arranged between the hours of 08.00 to 20.00 so as to minimise the disturbance caused to the neighbours

Use of external area's

External area's for loading, storage or putting out refuse will not be used between the hours of 11pm and 7am, to minimise noise disturbance to local residents.

Plant and machinery

All plant and machinery is correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that it is operating efficiently and with minimal disturbance to neighbours arising from noise

Dealing with complaints

A complaints book will be held on the premises to record details of any complaints received from neighbours. The information is to include, where disclosed, the complainant's name, location, date time and subsequent remedial action undertaken. This record must be made available at all times for inspection by council officers

Regular liaison meetings will be held where specifically requested by residents to enable neighbours to raise concerns about any aspect of the licensed activities

Prevention of nuisance from litter

Adequate receptacles for use by patrons will be provided in the local vicinity. The positioning of the receptacles will be agreed with the licensing officer

Prevention of Nuisance from Odour
