Suitable beverages other than alcohol including water shall be available with or otherwise ancillary to meals served the licences premises.



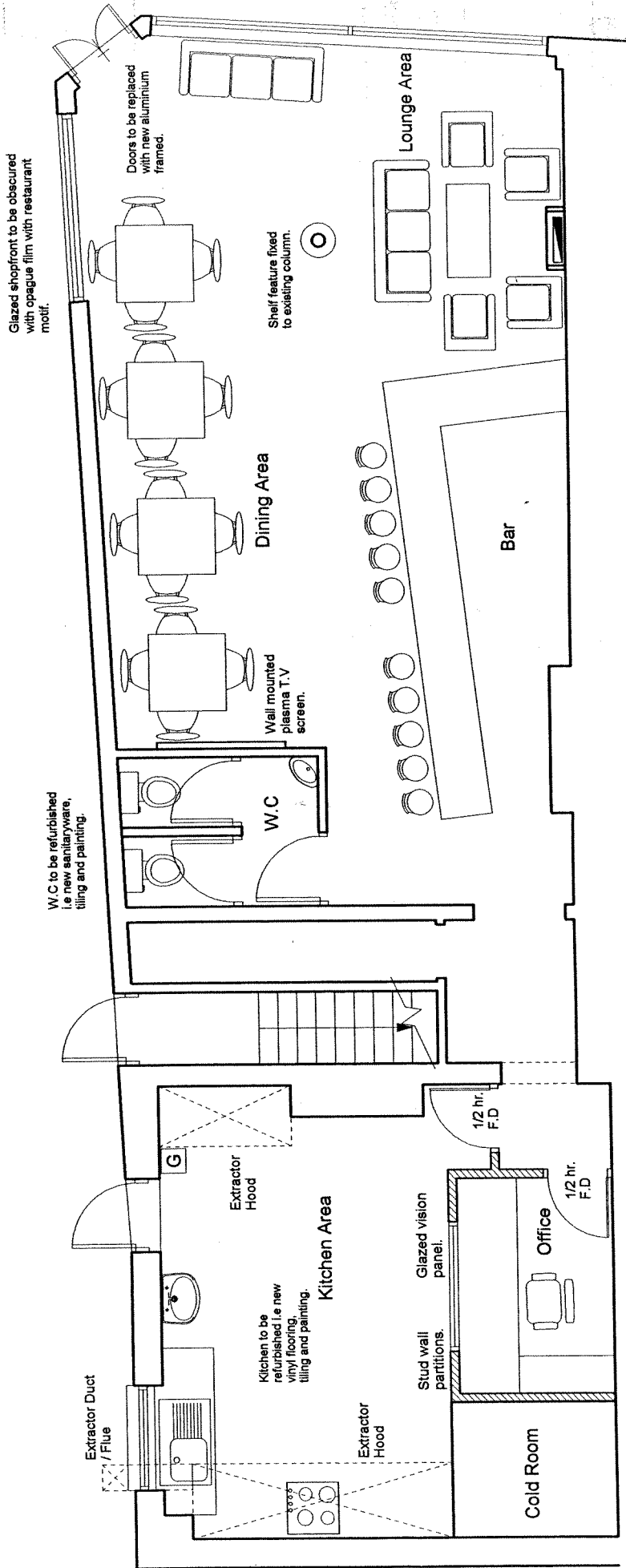

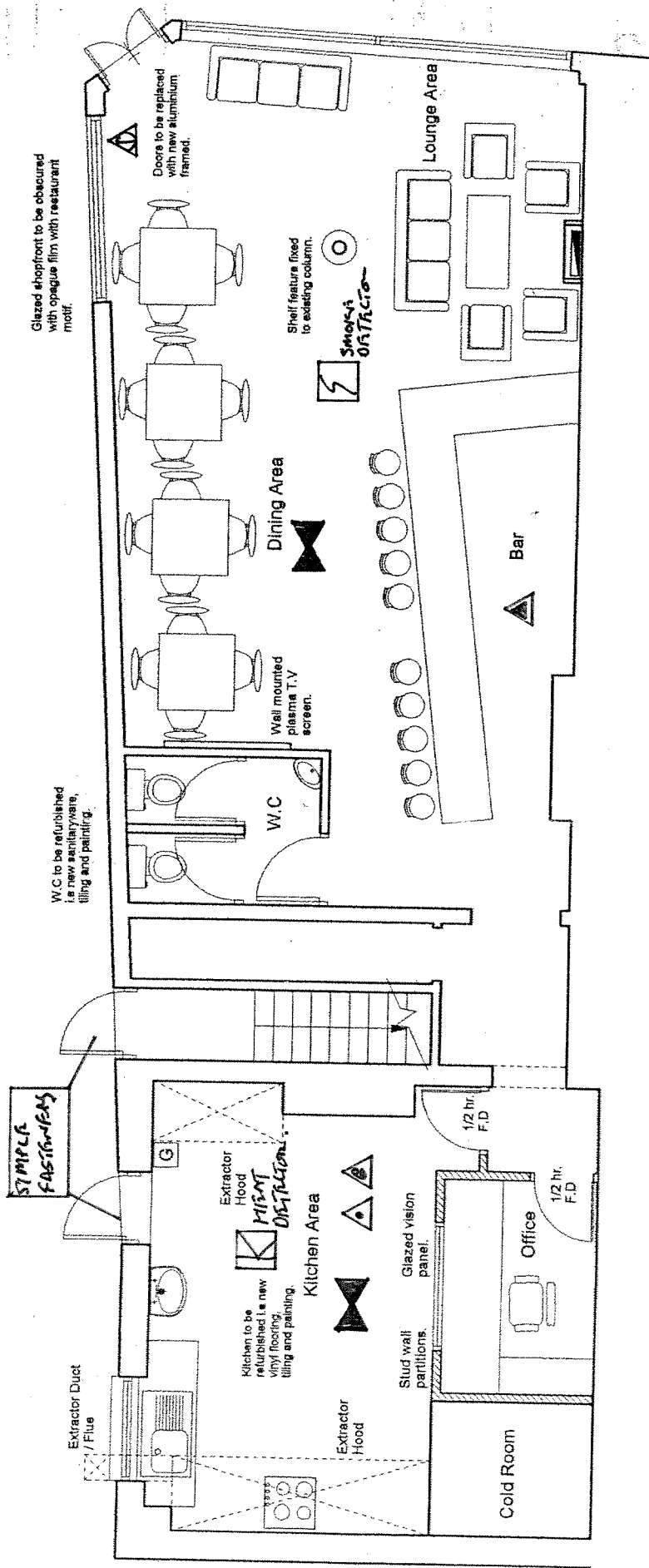
