GENERAL

Staff to be trained regularly on Licensing Provision and Saturday restaurant conditions. Intoxicating liquor shall not be sold or supplies on the premises other to persons taking table meals there and for consumption by such a person ancillary to their meal. Suitable beverages other that alcohol including water shell be a available with or otherwise ancillary to meals served the licences premises.

5.2 Crime and Disorder

CCTV coverage inside and outside the premises signs displayed informing the public passing the premises that recorded CCTV is in use at the premises. Any recording to be kept to a minimum of 31 Days




