Cease Salary Contribution to Jackson's Lane Luncheon Club

Description

A well established (early 1980's) luncheon club/arts club for older people which is based in Jackson's Lane Art Centre. This is not a Council service. The Council contributes £10.3k towards the cost of a part time worker who is employed by Jackson's Lane. It is a non-assessed "walk in" service. Service users pay for their meals through the Arts Centre restaurant. A proportion of service users live out of borough as this Centre is on the Borough boundary.

Medium impact but low risk for service users. The future of the service will depend on decisions made by the Jackson's Lane Board and in the wider context of Arts Council funding changes. These older people are not assessed as requiring an adult social care service.
