1. Purpose

- 1.1 To inform Member of the most recent figures for Haringey school exclusions

2. Introduction by Cabinet Member (if necessary)

- 2.1 We encourage all schools to use exclusion as a last resort and I am pleased that we have a number of schools, both primary and secondary, who have not had to exclude any pupils during this period. We also use our Pupil Referral Units to take pupils at risk of exclusion and work with them to avoid actual exclusions, often in conjunction with a managed move to another school.
- 2.2 This report and associated appendices contain a wealth of information about the background of excluded pupils and the schools they attend. This is included to ensure Scrutiny members can interrogate the data in sufficient detail to understand the full picture across the borough. I hope it also serves to reassure members that CYPS is properly monitoring what is going on in our schools to this group of pupils.

3. Recommendations

- 3.1 Current financial constraints will pose challenges in the provision of targeted support which focuses on vulnerable or disadvantaged groups whose needs may not be complex but who would benefit from early identification and intervention. Carefully planned restructuring of the remaining resources and personnel is crucial.
- 3.2 Target setting and strategic direction between Head teachers, councillors and service heads in regard to expectations for a borough wide reduction of exclusions is needed

8. Headlines

The trend for a decrease in secondary fixed term exclusions continues. The number of primary exclusions are static. The number of permanent exclusions for secondary schools, when compared to Autumn 2009/10, have decreased. Where there were no permanent exclusions for primary schools Autumn 2009/10 there are two so far this year. However the Inclusion Team in conjunction with the Primary Pupil Support Centre has been effective in diverting three permanent exclusions

9. Equalities Implications

- 9.1 This risk is a reality for Haringey pupils with approximately 45.3% of fixed term exclusions, being Black Caribbean and Black African children. Other statistically significant groups are Mixed Asian & Black and White British which comprise 10%

and 8.3% of fixed term exclusions respectively.

- 9.2 This pattern is mirrored in the data for permanent exclusions. Two of the four permanent exclusions at secondary were for black Caribbean/Black African students. One Asian and one White English student. Of the primary permanent exclusions one student was black Caribbean and the other White Irish

10. Conclusion

- 10.1 The need for early intervention for children most at risk of exclusion has been recognised and acted upon. Improved monitoring of data has resulted in focused discussions with schools and senior CYPS managers. Joint and multi faceted intervention of Inclusion Team and School Improvement Partners have had a particular focus on those primary schools causing concern. This will continue into the rest of the academic year.

On comparison of the Autumn figures 2009/10 and 2010/11 the number of fixed term exclusions for primary schools are static. However the number of days lost indicate an increase in the overall average of the length of exclusions.
The number of fixed term exclusions for secondary schools have fallen by 66%.

The number of permanent exclusions from primary schools rose from 0 Autumn term 2009/10 to 2 in Autumn term 2010/11.
The number of permanent exclusions fell from secondary fell from 9 to 4.

Developments

Plans for the academic year 2010/11 are focused on vulnerable children at tier three and four (according to the Haringey Threshold). Schools are being supported to develop/enhance robust systems for analysing data allowing for timely identification and intervention and to identify key areas for de escalation away from potential exclusion.

Via a well attended Behaviour Conference in November 2010, schools have had training on how to build on and improve mechanisms for preventative intervention and reduction of repeat exclusions by developing a revised Pastoral Support Plan, multi agency planning, Restorative Reintegration and managed moves

The Inclusion Team have encouraged schools to share concerns about children with multiple exclusions and who are at risk of or at the point of permanent exclusion through collaboration with Inclusion Managers and the primary and secondary pupil support centres. The completed refurbishment of both the Secondary Pupil Support Centre (now known as The Octagon) and The Primary Pupil Support Centre has ensured that we are now able to support children on assessment placements when they are at serious risk of permanent exclusion. Those children receive intensive behaviour intervention but in addition strategies are developed and transferred to their school in order to sustain an improvement. Through this programme The Primary Pupil Support Centre has averted permanent exclusions for three children this Autumn term. The pupil support centres continue to carry out their statutory functions.

Targeted training for school governors encourages their early involvement and contribution to a reduction in exclusions. Training encourages governors to take a more proactive role which encompasses involvement not only at the exclusion hearing stage but through the Head teacher's regular reporting on the impact of targeted interventions and multiple exclusions and exclusions for children with protected characteristics.
