5. REPORT

Background

Application by KRIMSON LTD., for a Variation of a Premises Licence in respect of ROSE AND CROWN, 86 HIGHGATE HIGH STREET, HIGHGATE, LONDON, N6 5HX under the Licensing Act 2003.

KRIMSON LTD. have applied for a variation to their existing licence and to extend the hours of the sale of alcohol and provide regulated entertainment as well as late night refreshment.

Current Licence details.

OPERATING SCHEDULE

General

The types of regulated entertainment proposed re-instate & then enhance the normal pub entertainment that were previously unregulated, with the benefit to enhance the local facilities for social entertainment & reduce the focus on alcohol.

Staff are to be trained on the requirement of the Licensing Act 2003 when recruited.

No new steps have been identified by risk assessment in relation to the four licensing objectives, except as below.

I have considered the terms of your local licensing policy in preparing this application

5.1 Crime and Disorder

Providing a 30 minute extension of opening hours after the end of the sale of alcohol will promote this objective as the last drinks will be consumed less quickly, with access to the pub's toilet facilities.

Not less than five working days written notice will be provided to Police, if they require it, when 'Events Days' are planned.

No customers will be admitted to the premises carrying open bottles whilst they are open to the public.

Unless by way of a genuine off-sale Alcoholic drinks may not be removed from the premises save for consumption in any external area provided for that purpose.

5.2 Public Safety

- No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below
- To comply with the reasonable requirements of the Fire Officer from time to time.
- To comply with the reasonable requirements of the Building Control Officer.

5.5 Public Nuisance

No further risks have been identified which need to be addressed, save as below.

Where appropriate, prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits requesting the public respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

Noise or vibration shall not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties.

Kitchen extractors shall be cleaned on a regular basis to minimise the impact of cooking smells on neighbours.

5.6 Child Protection

The restrictions set out in the Licensing Act 2003 will apply.

Photographic proof of age will be required to be shown by anyone seeking to purchase alcohol who appears to be under 18 years of age.

No unusual or additional risks of harm to children have been identified.

Children under the age of 16 will not be permitted to enter the premises after 21.00 hours.

- the applicant having confirmed that there are to be no changes made to the Licensing conditions associated with the rear garden I have no comment in this regard. There are still concerns that noise nuisance may arise from the use of the rear garden but the noise team will consider any complaints made and make an individual assessment on each occasion.
- in regard to the playing of music inside the premises until lam (rather than the current 12 midnight) I noted that the rear door has a lobby and the other window is fixed and doesn't open. I would recommend that the applicant rigorously emphasises that staff should not permit both rear doors to the lobby to be open whilst music is playing. The applicant should be aware that it may be necessary to reduce the volume of music after midnight to prevent noise nuisance from occurring





Further to our meeting this afternoon at the Rose and Crown 86 Highgate High Street N6 I confirm the following

- the applicant having confirmed that there are to be no changes made to the Licensing conditions associated with the rear garden I have no comment in this regard. There are still concerns that noise nuisance may arise from the use of the rear garden but the noise team will consider any complaints made and make an individual assessment on each occasion.
- in regard to the playing of music inside the premises until lam (rather than the current 12 midnight) I noted that the rear door has a lobby and the other window is fixed and doesn't open. I would recommend that the applicant rigorously emphasises that staff should not permit both rear doors to the lobby to be open whilst music is playing. The applicant should be aware that it may be necessary to reduce the volume of music after midnight to prevent noise nuisance from occurring
