Background

5.1 An application for a new Premises Licence, by Juliana Adetoun Orekan in respect of Mighty Rock Restaurant, 363 High Road, Tottenham, London N17 6QN under the Licensing Act 2003.

5.3 General

- Appropriate staff training will be provided.
- The premises will be managed and controlled by a responsible adult at all times.
- No binge drinking promotions will take place.
- Any person who appears to be drunk / aggressive will not be permitted on the premises.
- Notices will be placed in prominent positions to ask patrons to leave the premises quietly.
- There will be a suitable evacuation plan in place, in case of emergency.
- Premise is smoke free and the required signs will be displayed at all times.

5.4 Crime and Disorder

- Internal and external CCTV will be installed at the premises.
- A full alarm system will be installed and maintained at the premises.
- No binge drinking promotions will take place.

- No glasses or bottles of alcohol shall be taken off the premises.
- Any person who appears to be drunk / aggressive will not be permitted on the premises.
- Registration with crime prevention initiatives run by the police.

5.5 Public Safety

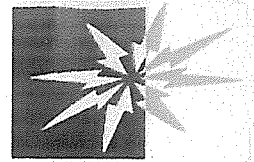
9.0 Licensing Officer Comments

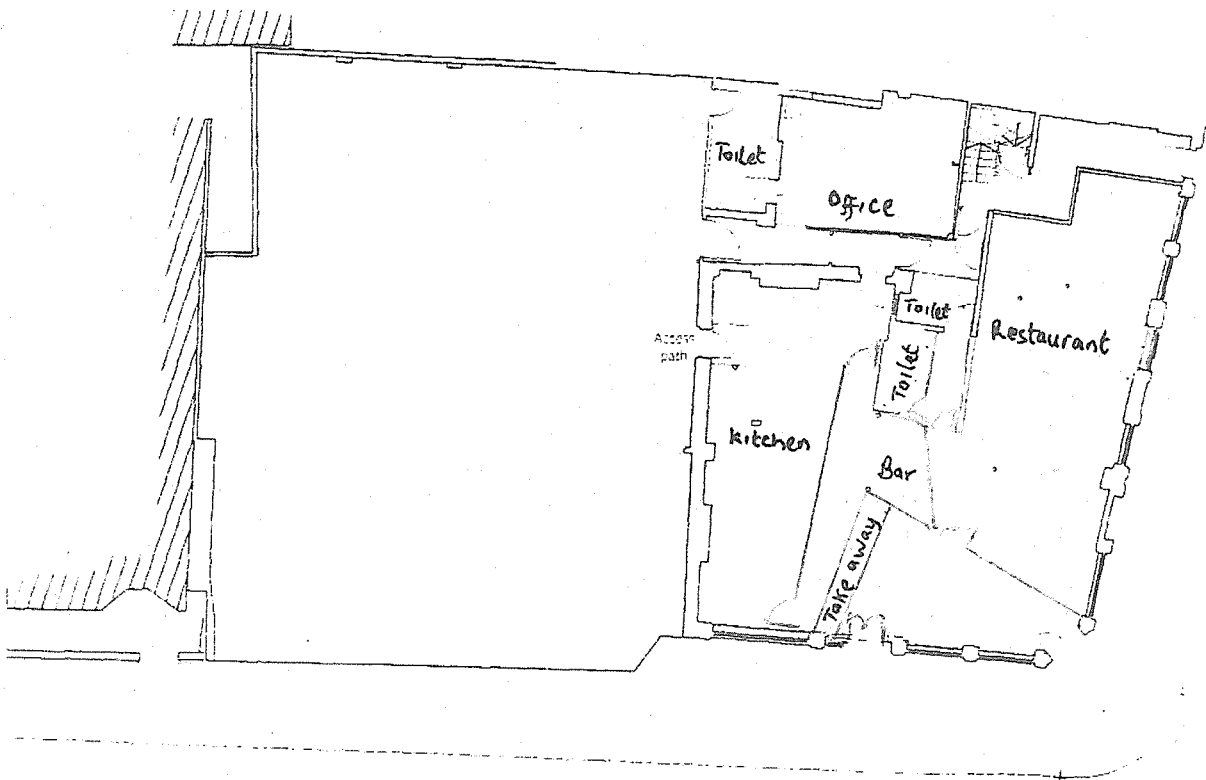


LOCATION PLAN

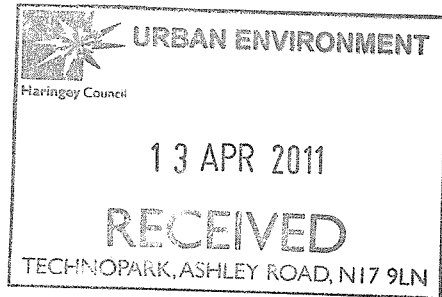

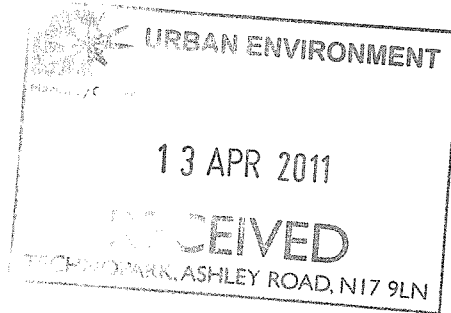
