Luncheon Club Benchmarking Exercise

A short survey was carried out with other London boroughs to establish whether in-house luncheon clubs are provided for older people. Responses were received from 21 local authorities, of which just one directly provides a lunch club for older people. The results of the survey are summarised below.
