Dear Colleagues,

I would like to inform you of work we are undertaking regarding dangerous dog issues within the Borough and how you can help us.

Robert Curtis, Service Manager for Street Enforcement is operating as Haringey's Dangerous Dog Coordinator. His role here is to gather intelligence from available sources and work with a range of Haringey agencies and the Met Police Status Dog Unit to formulate appropriate action and operations. For example the Bruce Grove Safer Neighbourhood Police Team has now been trained to deal with dangerous dog issues and is actively carrying out operations to challenge anti social behaviour in relation to dogs and irresponsible owners. Some of these operations have already culminated in the seizure and destruction of dangerous dogs and the prosecution of their owners.
