
How Haringey compares with London - Interim 2011/12 Q1 data

This is a modified version of the London Indicator Set Dashboard produced by London Councils based on voluntary submissions from local authorities. This means that there may be issues around data quality and the information should be interpreted with care.

Of the 29 indicators, 7 had returns from more than 25 London boroughs, a further 11 had returns for 20-24 London boroughs and the remaining 11 had returns for less than 20 London Boroughs (indicators with less than 20 returns are marked in italics). Relative performance might change if data was available for all boroughs. This is interim data and may be subject to change.
