Consultation on Service Changes in Enfield & Haringey

Please find enclosed a series of documents that outline changes the Trust is proposing to make to improve the effectiveness of the community services it provides.

We set out our broad plan and objectives for the year in April which was circulated for comment to all partners. This led to much helpful and constructive dialogue across the three boroughs. We have now reached a more detailed stage in our planning and delivery of services, so, are continuing our engagement to ensure these best met local needs. All of these proposals have been built up with extensive local discussion and are agreed with PCT colleagues as being consistent with local strategies and commissioning plans.
