Muswell Hill Sustainability Group

Muswell Hill Sustainability Group was set up by local residents in 2008 to encourage households, businesses and community buildings in Muswell Hill to reduce their energy use and waste. We've delivered the Muswell Hill Low Carbon Zone project (in partnership with Haringey Council), put up solar panels on M & S on Muswell Hill Broadway and on a local church and we hold regular practical workshops on how to reduce residents' energy bills and carbon emissions. We have set up a Low Carbon Buying Group to offer discounted prices on expensive energy-saving measures such as solar renewables, new boilers and window replacement which 50 local residents have already taken advantage of. We are also a campaigning group, with our latest campaign targetting excess packaging by retailers and food outlets.
