In the 3 year rolling average calculation 2010-13 the 2009/10 average will drop off leaving the 2012/13 average to be added to the average days for 2010/11 (784) and 2011/12 (715). The 2012/13 average will therefore need to reduce significantly if Haringey is to achieve the national threshold of 639 days. Assuming equal numbers of adoptions each year, an average of 418 days would be required for 2012/13 in order to meet the national threshold.
