Background

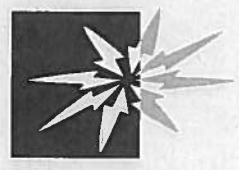



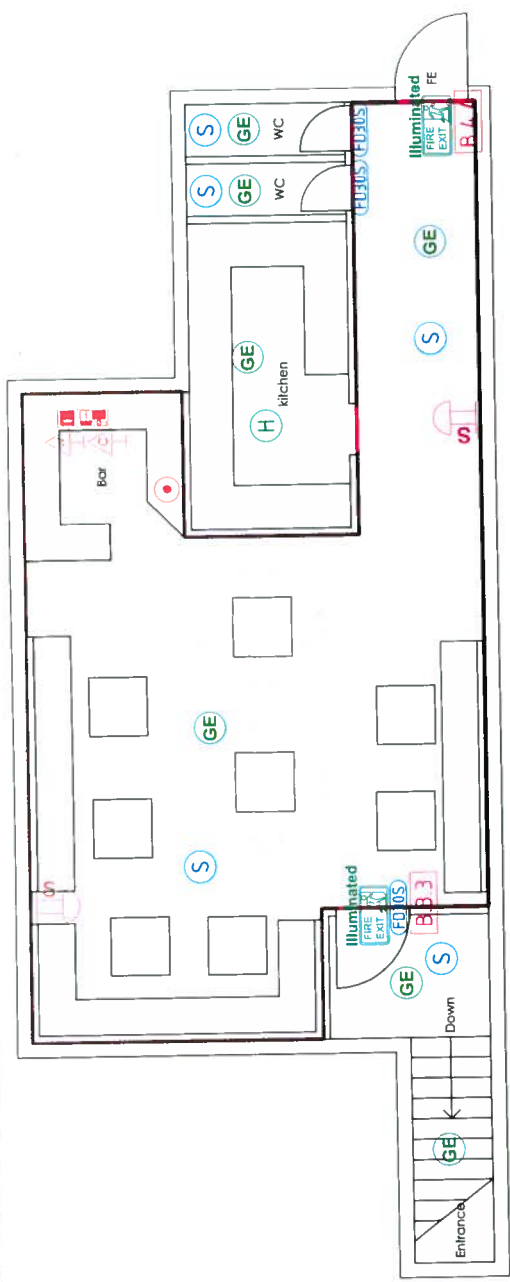

Alarm should be interphased with the entertainment system to silence music when in use. Symbols on plan indicate rooms to be covered, and actual location of detector heads are to be advised by a specialist fire alarm consultant
- FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT**
All fire fighting equipment to be set so that the carry handles are located 1.5m above floor level. All equipment to be subject to annual testing by a competent person
- EMERGENCY LIGHTING**
Premises to be covered with emergency lighting to standard set out in BS 5266: Part 1:2002 The code of practice for the emergency lighting of premises other than cinemas.
- All exits to be indicated by the use of maintained illuminated exit signs. All other areas to be illuminated by general emergency lighting
