



I would like to confirm that I have considered the above proposal with regard to the prevention of public nuisance on behalf of the Enforcement Response (Noise) Team & would like to make representations to the Application

The operating schedule does not address the prevention of public nuisance from:

- airborne entertainment noise
- · Structure bome noise or vibrations from entertainment
- Noise generated by patrons in external areas of the premises
- Noise generated from deliveries
- · Noise generated from refuse collections
- Noise from plant and machinery
- Light nuisance
- Cooking odour

Prevention of nuisance from noise / vibration

All doors and windows will remain closed during the licensed regulated entertainment activities or in any event after 11pm. The entrance door will be fitted with a self-closing device and staff required to ensure that it is not propped open. A member of staff shall be made responsible to ensure the door is opened for as brief a period as possible. Where necessary adequate and suitable mechanical ventilation should be provided to public areas

The regulated entertainment licensable activity shall conclude 30 minutes before the premises is due to close to prevent excessive noise breakout as the premises empties

Structure borne noise

All speakers are mounted on anti-vibration mountings to prevent vibration transmission of sound energy to adjoining properties

Sound limits

The licensee shall ensure that no music played in the licensed premises is audible at or within the site boundary of any residential property

All regulated entertainment amplified activity will utilise the in-house amplification system, the maximum output of which is controlled by the duty manager

The level of amplified regulated entertainment shall be controlled by means of limiting device set at a level which upon request may be agreed with the licensing authority

Outside Areas

No music will be played in, or for the benefit of patrons in external areas of the premises premises

No form of loudspeaker or sound amplification equipment is to be sited on or near the exterior premises or in or near any foyer, doorway, window or opening to the premises

Signs shall be displayed in the external areas/on the frontage requesting patrons to recognise the residential nature of the area and conduct their behaviour accordingly. The management must reserve the right to ask patrons to move inside the premises or leave if it is felt that they could be disturbing neighbours

Thank you for your recent letter, which was forwarded by Haringey Council to both myself and my business partner, Stephen Lironi, earlier today.

We were sorry to hear of your distress caused by the owners of the previous bars, Rhythm and Bar 29 and wanted to write to you personally about our plans for the space.

Although the name of our restaurant does suggest a bar, we will actually be opening a Spanish tapas restaurant. We do not expect to attract a late night bar crowd, nor will we market the new business as such. We have spent the last two years researching high quality Spanish products and ingredients and special regional tapas dishes which we hope the Crouch End community will enjoy. In addition, our wine list will be specializing in Spanish wines and sherries.

In terms of noise, we are sympathetic to all of our neighbors and understand that this has been an issue in the past. We do not intend for our restaurant to have blaring music – in fact we believe that music should never drown out normal levels of conversation. In addition, we can guarantee that no speakers will be placed on the adjacent wall to your property and we do not intend to install a large music system and large speakers.
