### Briefing note of Executive Member for Environment and Conservation

#### Recreation

- manifesto commitments for green flags and trees
- strategic issues:
  - sustaining parks and open spaces improvements
  - exploiting Olympics and BSF opportunities
  - enlisting voluntary sector capacity and support
  - links to wider well-being agenda
  - management arrangements for leisure centres
- investment proposals:
  - capital: parks and trees match funding
  - revenue: parks maintenance, leisure transfer resources, reduced concert income target
- savings proposals; target met:
  - price increases
  - tax savings from leisure transfer to trust

#### Streetscene

- manifesto commitments for recycling, street lights, cleaner streets, graffiti, low parking charges
- strategic issues:
  - key Better Haringey services
  - recycling target of 35% in NLWA strategy
  - waste/recycling procurement or insourcing in 2009
  - establish policy case for controlled parking
- investment proposals:
  - co-mingled, borough-wide recycling collections
  - cleaner streets
  - highways asset management plan

- savings proposals: target met:
  - parking plan: more CPZs, more cameras, permit charge increases
  - integrated waste contract efficiencies

### Planning (transport)

- strategic issues:
  - transport issues in strategic sites planning
  - Mayoral/TfL policy and resources
