**Re. Reduction of the PAN for Hornsey School for Girls from September 2014**

Thank you for attending a meeting with myself, the Headteacher and senior school staff last week (14/12/12) at Hornsey School for Girls (HSG).

I write to confirm what was agreed at the meeting, most specifically that Hornsey School for Girls wishes to reduce its PAN to become a six form entry school as soon as possible. You recommended that this would take place from September 2014 as the Admissions prospectus for 2013 has already been produced and admissions are currently being processed.

As you know HSG has, currently, over seventy surplus places in Year 7 and initial analysis for admissions 2013 looks set to repeat this surplus. In order to help the school with its future planning, particularly its staffing projections, it is important to reduce the PAN. We all understand that that may need to change in the future once the 'Primary bulge' works its way through to the Secondary sector.

As Chair of Governors of Hornsey School for Girls I request that Haringey LA supports this request.
