The Local Plan is the principal document of the Local Development Framework and sets out the long term spatial vision and strategy for delivering and managing growth in Haringey over the next 15 years.

An independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, considered the Local Plan at an Examination in Public held on 28th June – 6th July 2011 and an additional hearing on 22nd February 2012.

The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations was received by the Council on 17th December 2012 and is published on the Council's website. The adopted Local Plan Strategic Policies contains the Inspector's recommendations that the Council have accepted.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Local Plan Strategic Policies may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made no later than the end of the six week period from the date of adoption (18th March 2013).
