

I note that there is an application made for the grant of an off licence for these premises to trade for 24 hours daily.

I propose to object to this application. My reasons for this objection are:

(1) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety and Public Nuisance

There are already three premises offering 24 hour licensing facilities in the locality and I fear that a further similar license will encourage more and more potential patrons to come into the area at all times of the day and particularly at nighttimes and early mornings when alcohol is not available elsewhere. These additional people will make for increased tension between groups of people who are likely to have consumed various quantities of alcohol thus they would be boisterous and volatile. I also believe on football match days when the Arsenal are playing at home the sale of alcohol from these premises would add to the potential for problems long before the pubs are open when visiting fans and other patrons would purchase alcohol and then proceed to consume it in the streets and on my pub forecourt which when I open my patrons will want to use. These people will then want to dispose of empty bottles/cans - or leave them to litter my premises and the streets generally thus causing great disorder and nuisance.

Finally I believe in these circumstances the need to urinate will cause problems as we accept only patrons as users follow toilet facilities.
