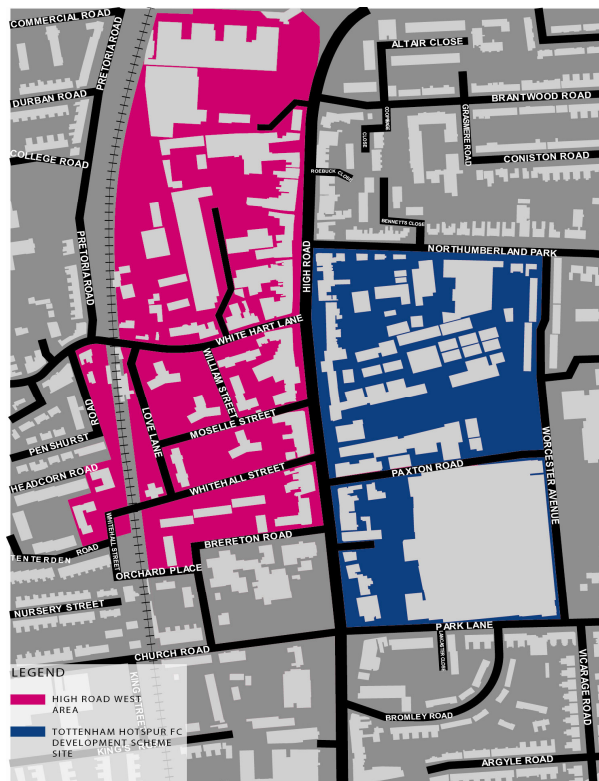

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Between the **29th April and 21st June 2013** Haringey Council will be undertaking an 8 week public consultation to seek residents' views on the proposals for the High Road West Area.
- 1.2 This paper sets out the background and purpose of the consultation and explains how and when the consultation will be conducted.

2. Background and purpose of consultation

- 2.1 In 2012 the Council employed a company called Arup to work with them to produce a master plan for the High Road West area. The High Road West and master plan area is shown in the map below.



- 2.2 Between February and December 2012, the Council and Arup undertook a series of consultations with residents and businesses in the High Road West area to determine what aspirations and issues there were for the area. The local community informed us that their priorities are to:

- improve the quality of homes,
- tackle crime and anti-social behaviour,
- generate local jobs and opportunities,

- improve the High Road and have more facilities for the local community and
- create better public open spaces.

2.3 Since this consultation, we have been working with Arup to develop three different options for change in the High Road West area.

2.4 The three options show three different ways that the improvements and change listed above can be made to the area. We now want local residents' views on these three master plan options.

2.5 Your views and feedback will then be used to develop the preferred master plan later in the year.

3.0 Consultation

3.1 Who will the Council be consulting with?

3.1 The Council will be consulting with all residents and local businesses and services within the High Road West Area.

3.2 The consultation area will extend 300 m beyond the master plan area to ensure that the Council seeks the views of the wider community, who will also be affected by the redevelopment proposals. The consultation area is detailed in the map at appendix 1.

3.3 How will the Council be consulting?

3.4 So that residents, local businesses and the wider community in the High Road West area can see the three options and give us their views, we shall be holding a series of consultation drop - in sessions.

3.5 At the drop - in sessions, people will be able to:

- Meet the Consultation Team – led by the Council with Homes for Haringey and Arup
- See the three development options for change
- Give us their views on the area and to shape the future
- Find out how we shall incorporate their views and the next steps for the project.
