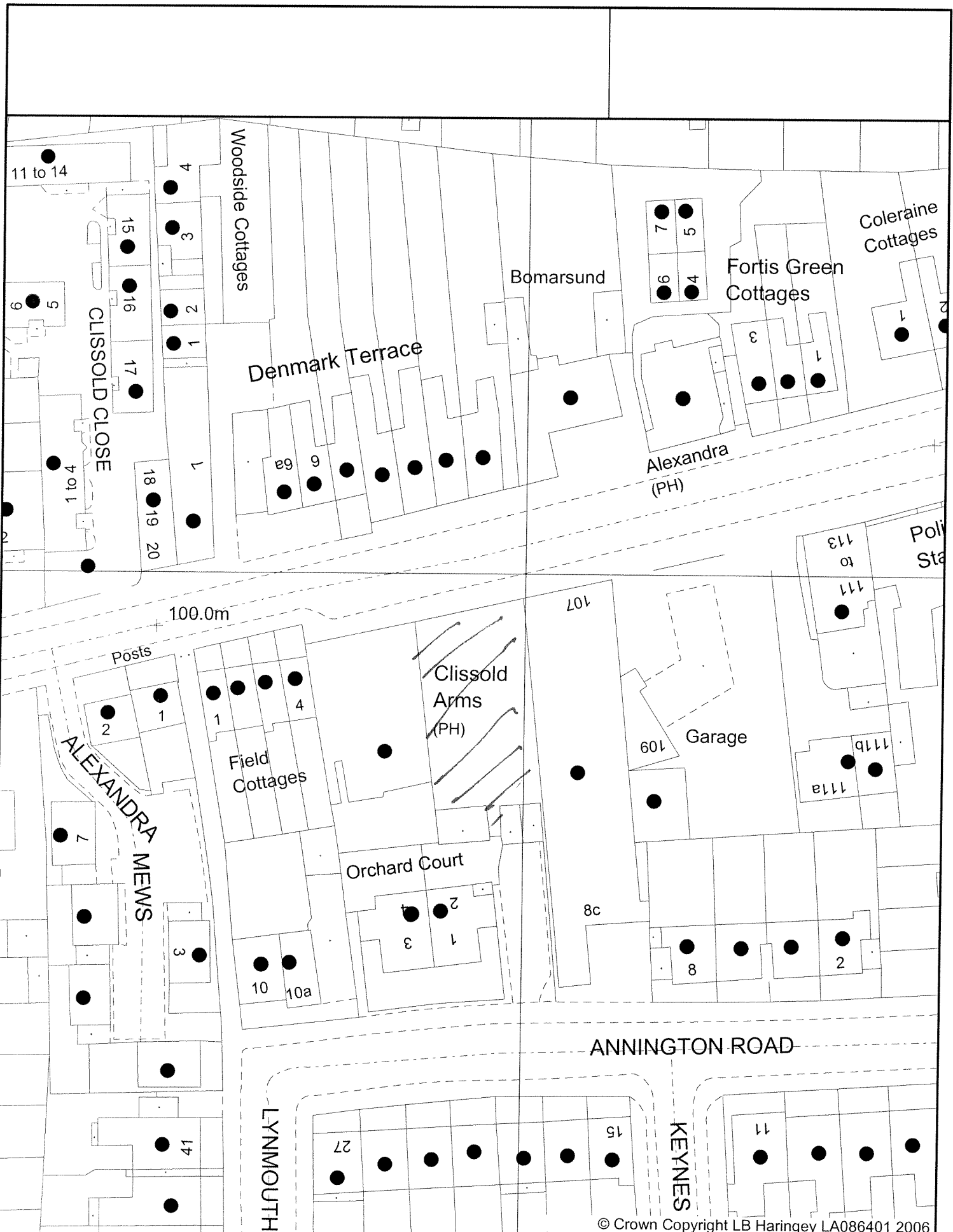

It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with a Licence Application. The maximum fine on summary conviction is £5000.00.

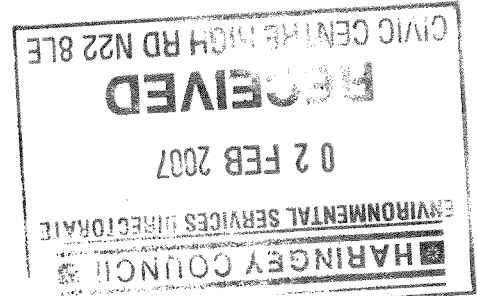


I wish to object to the proposed hours of operation and serving of alcohol and food as proposed for the Clissold Arms.

The public house is in an area of mainly residential development and there is no town centre or social dynamic that would be usefully served by the pub being open until midnight and beyond.


