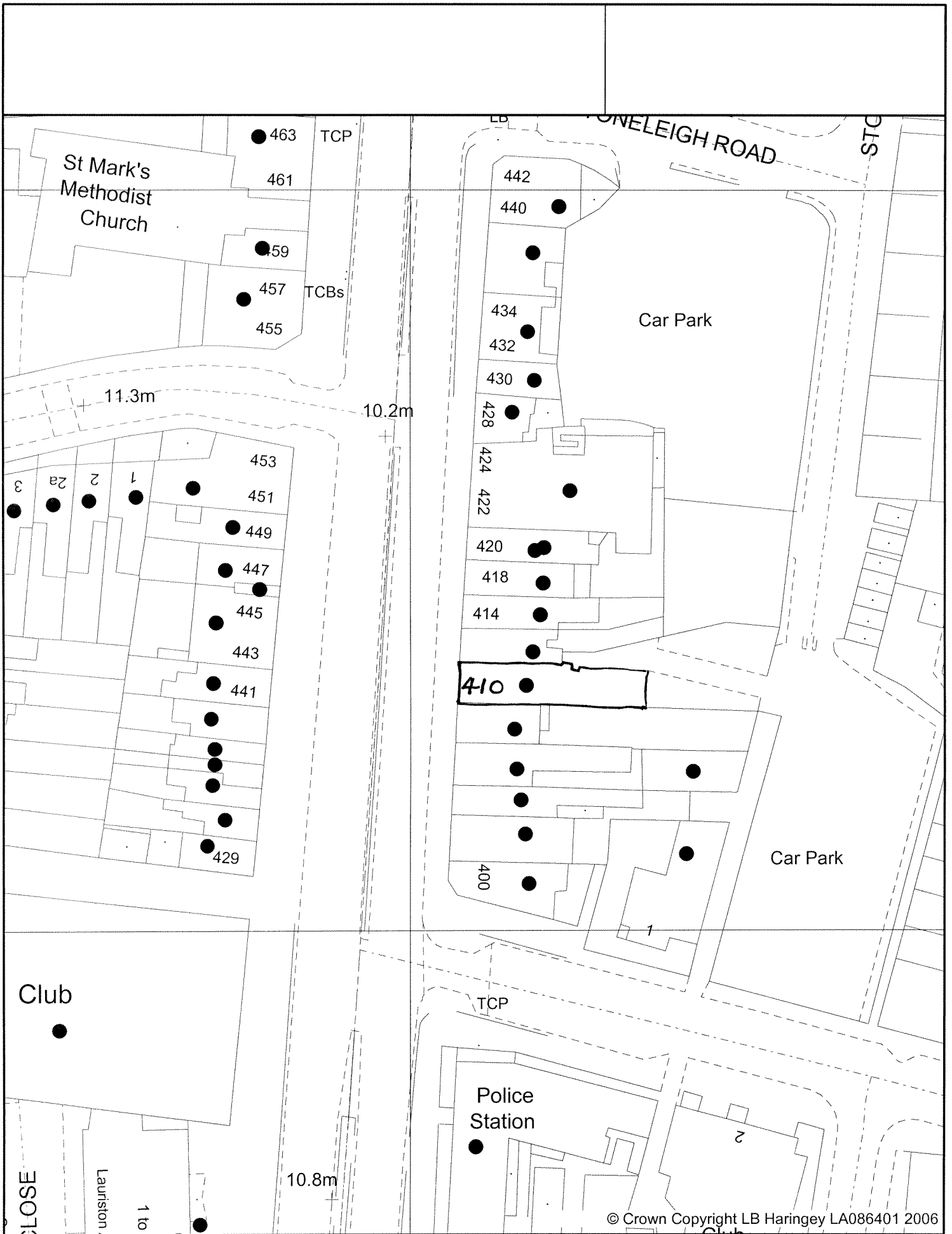

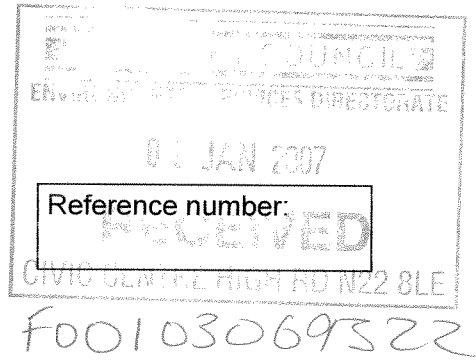

OUR MAIN OBJECTIVE IS TO PROVIDE OUR CUSTOMERS A SAFE AND AN ENJOYABLE AREA TO SPEND THEIR FREE TIMES IN. WE ALSO AIM TO PROMOTE THE TURKISH/KURDISH ETHNIC MUSIC. WE HAVE HAD SUGGESTIONS BY OUR EXISTING CUSTOMERS THAT WE SHOULD DO EVENINGS SUCH AS THESE AND THAT IT WILL BE A VERY NICE PLACE TO VISIT.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

OUR CUSTOMER BASE IS MAINLY THE ENTELLETUAL AND STUDENTS WHO WISH TO SOCIALISE AND/OR ENJOY THE FOOD WE SUPPLY OR THE BOOKS THEREFORE WE HAVE NOT HAD TROUBLE FROM ANYONE. WE DO HAVE 24 HOUR CCTV CAMERAS OPERATING. WE ALSO HOPE TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STAFF (WAITERS/WAITRESSES) ON THE DAYS WE PROVIDE ALCHOL AND LIVE MUSIC.

c) Public safety

WE HAVE NOT SO FAR CAUSED ANY BREACH OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY REGULATIONS AND WILL CONTINUE NOT TO ONCE WE OBTAIN THIS PREMISE LICENCE. WE HAVE A FIRE ALARM IN EACH SECTION OF THE PREMISES; KITCHEN, RESTAURANT AREA, INTERNET CAFE AREA AND UPSTAIRS FIRST FLOOR, WE ALSO KEEP 6 FIRE EXTINGUISHERS AT EACH POINT OF THE PREMISES AND EXTRA FIRE BLANKET IN THE KITCHEN

d) The prevention of public nuisance

WE WILL PREVENT ANY NUISANCE TO OUR NEIGHBOURS AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC WITH THE LIVE MUSIC, AS I HAVE MENTIONED EARLIER THE TYPE OF MUSIC WE HOPE TO MAKE IS OF LOW BASS. WHICH COMPRISE OF TWO STRING INSTRUMENTS AND FLUTE. THE MUSIC IS OF LOW VOLUME AND WILL NOT CAUSE ANY NOISE NUISANCE TO THE PUBLIC.

e) The protection of children from harm

WE NORMALLY HAVE NO CHILDREN ON PREMISES AFTER 9 'O'CLOCK. HOWEVER ON THE DAYS WE HOPE TO HAVE LIVE MUSIC WE WILL NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO ATTEND. IF WE HAVE TO HOLD PRIVATE PARTIES, THEN WE WILL PROVIDE A CRESSH AREA UPSTAIRS SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT IN ORDER TO KEEP THE CHILDREN AWAY FROM SMOKE AND ALCHOL.
