Appendix B -

1.0 The existing ESP scheme

1.1 There are currently four categories of ESPs and the qualifying criteria are highlighted below;

Building Maintenance

 Those involved in building maintenance, whether or not it applies to private or public sector housing / buildings.

Other

- Those involved in the delivery of essential services to residents and require as part of their job to carry heavy [or hazardous] equipment or materials.
- Those involved in the delivery of essential services to residents who are required to work extended unsociable hours or are on 24-hour call out.

Schools

Schools are considered on an individual business case basis. The factors that are be considered are operational needs, availability of car park space at the school or in the immediate area, and proximity to public transport facilities. If an application is accepted permits are issued to a named member of staff, for term time only and they may only be used a roads immediately around the school.

Ministers of Religion

- Ministers of religion qualify for a permit as there is a need for them to attend residents in their own homes.

ESPs may not be used to facilitate all day parking. They may not be used at all in Cumberland Road, Ringslade Road, Warberry Road, Selborne Road, Ranelagh Road, Wolseley Road, Bradley Road, Barratt Avenue, Parkland Road, and Tower Terrace.

2.0 The existing Business scheme

- 2.1 Business permits are issued to Business in controlled Parking Zones (CPZs), where the use of a vehicle is essential for the running of that business. The application process ensures appropriate evidence to support the application.
- 2.2 Business permit holders may only park is dedicated Business or permit bays (shared with pay & display users). The charge is currently £254.60 for an annual permit.
