1. Purpose

For the Committee to consider whether it is appropriate to impose interim steps on the premises license pending the determination of a summary review of the premises license which has been applied for by Inspector of the Metropolitan police. The application has been made in accordance with section 53A of the Licensing Act 2003.

Summary of application

- A senior police officer (defined as an officer who is a superintendant or above) has given a certificate to the Licensing Authority which states that it is his/her opinion that the premises are associated with serious crime or disorder or both.


A copy of the review application and certificate are at Appendix 1.
