2. Introduction

- 2.1 The attached performance information is presented on single A4 sheets and aims to focus discussion on the areas of exception linked to our key MOPAC targets. Where performance has improved exceptionally, it may also be worth considering whether this is well understood and/or can be maintained. This will be presented by theme and CSP leads for each area.
- 1.1 There is no separate sheet for outcome 1. The main target is confidence in police, measured by survey. The latest figure will be presented at the board meeting. At year end, this had improved to 60% from a starting point of 50% but Haringey was still at or near the bottom of the MPS as a whole.
- 1.2 There has been a substantial, positive change relating to Stop and Search performance which will be brought to the meeting.
- 1.3 Of particular note is the positive direction of travel across all three Youth Offending targets (see attached) after a challenging last financial year.
- 1.4 At the time of writing, information was not available for sexual offending but the latest data will be brought to the table due to the importance of this area to the borough.
