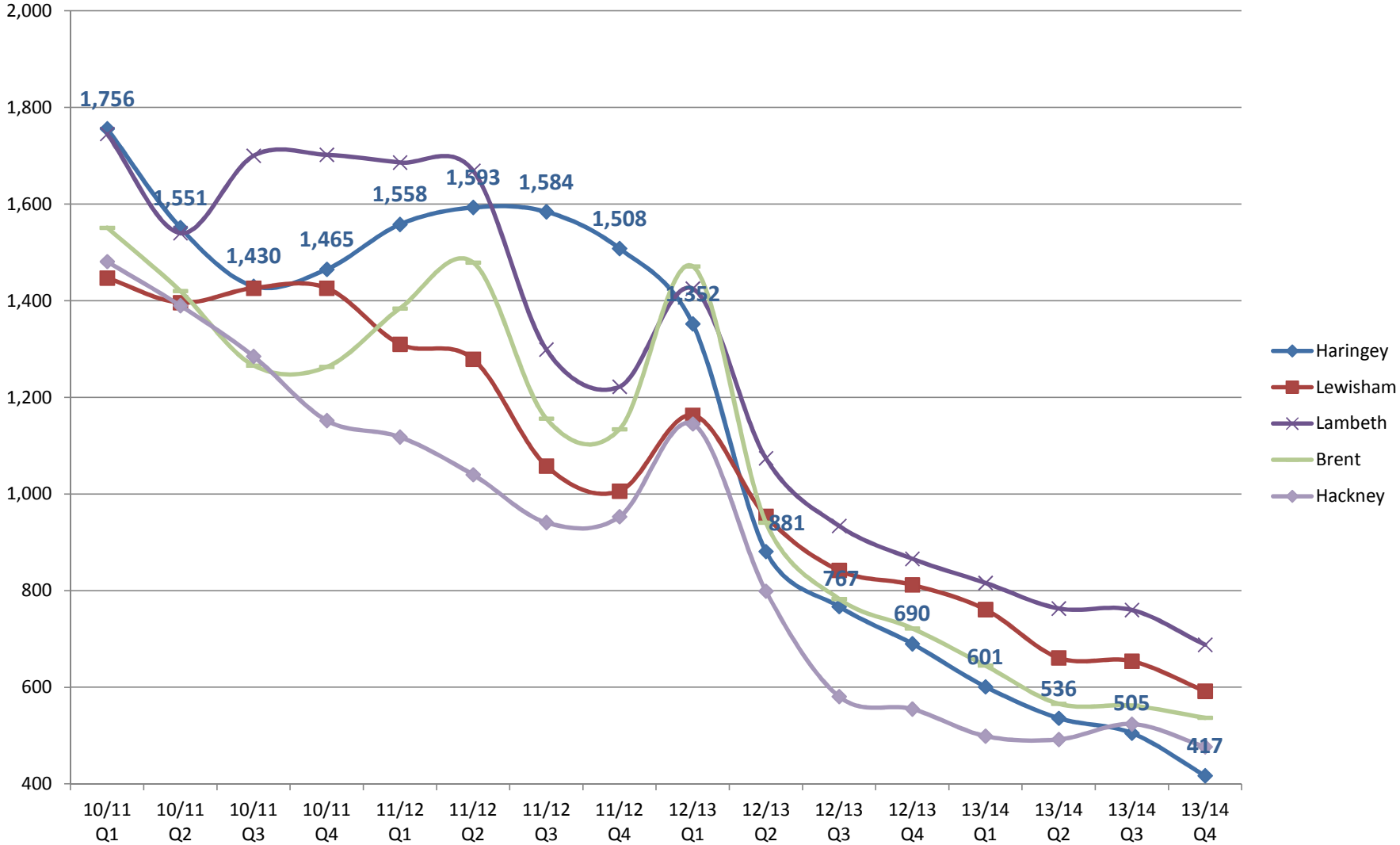

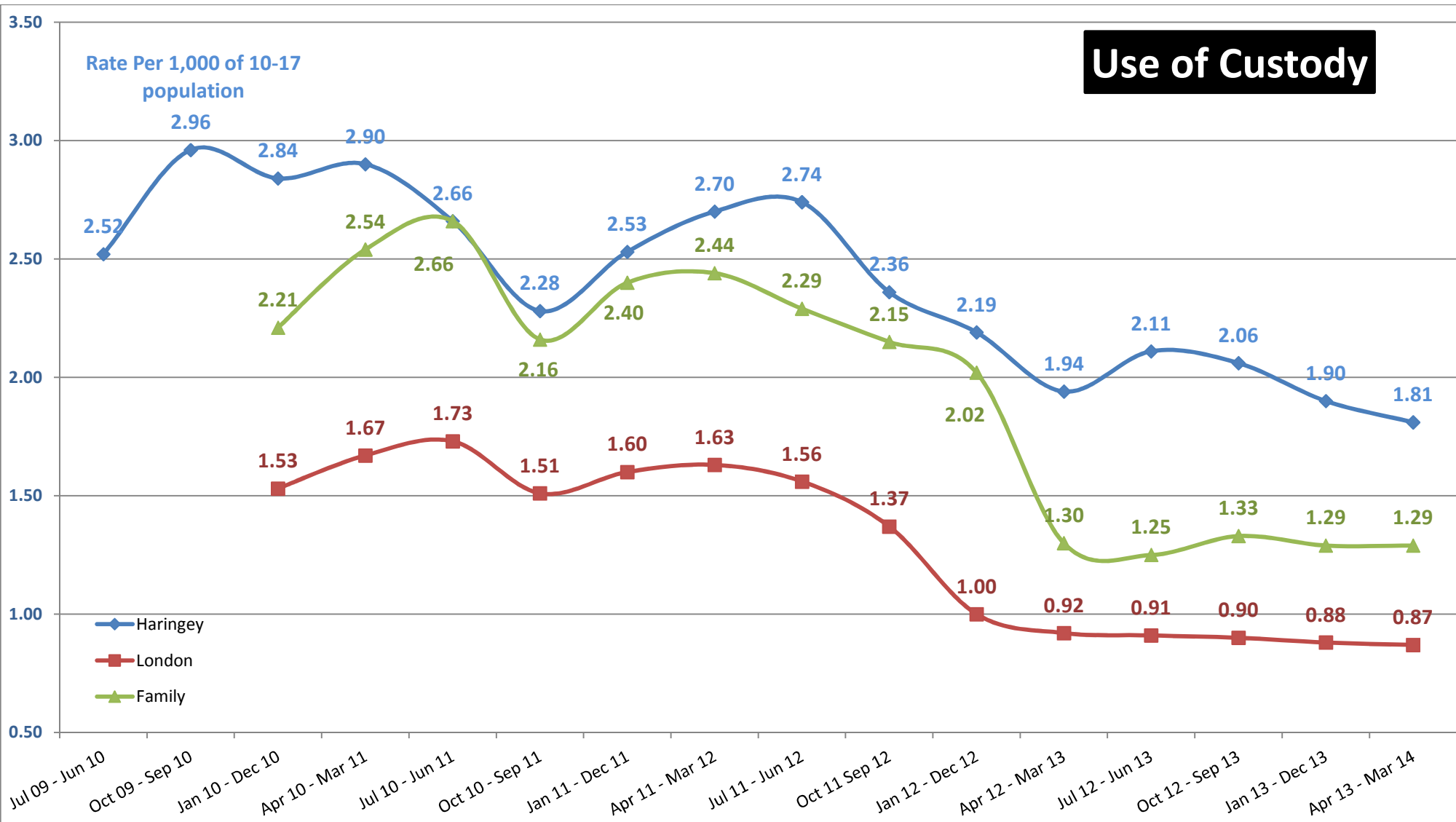

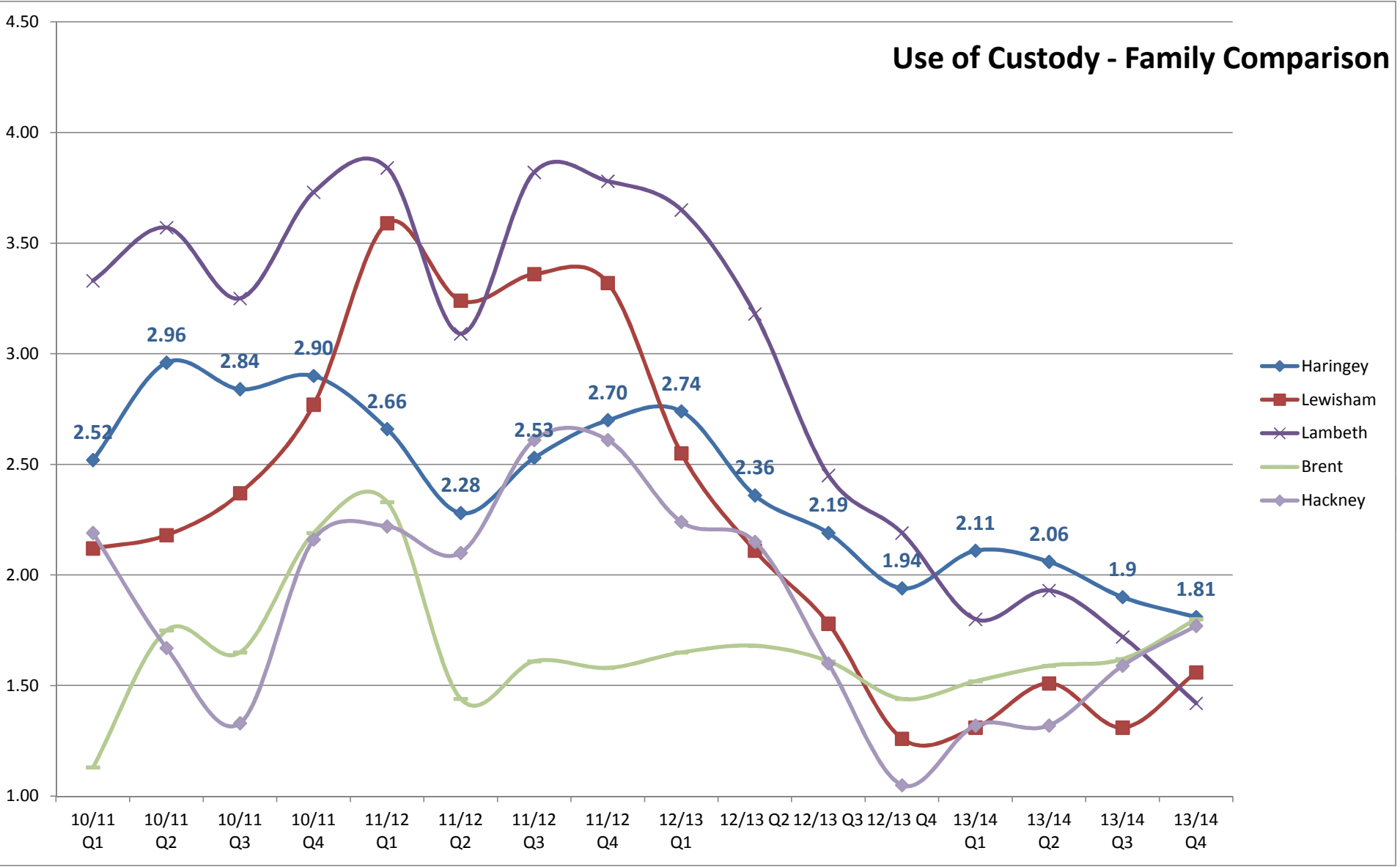
Rate Per 1,000 of 10-17 population

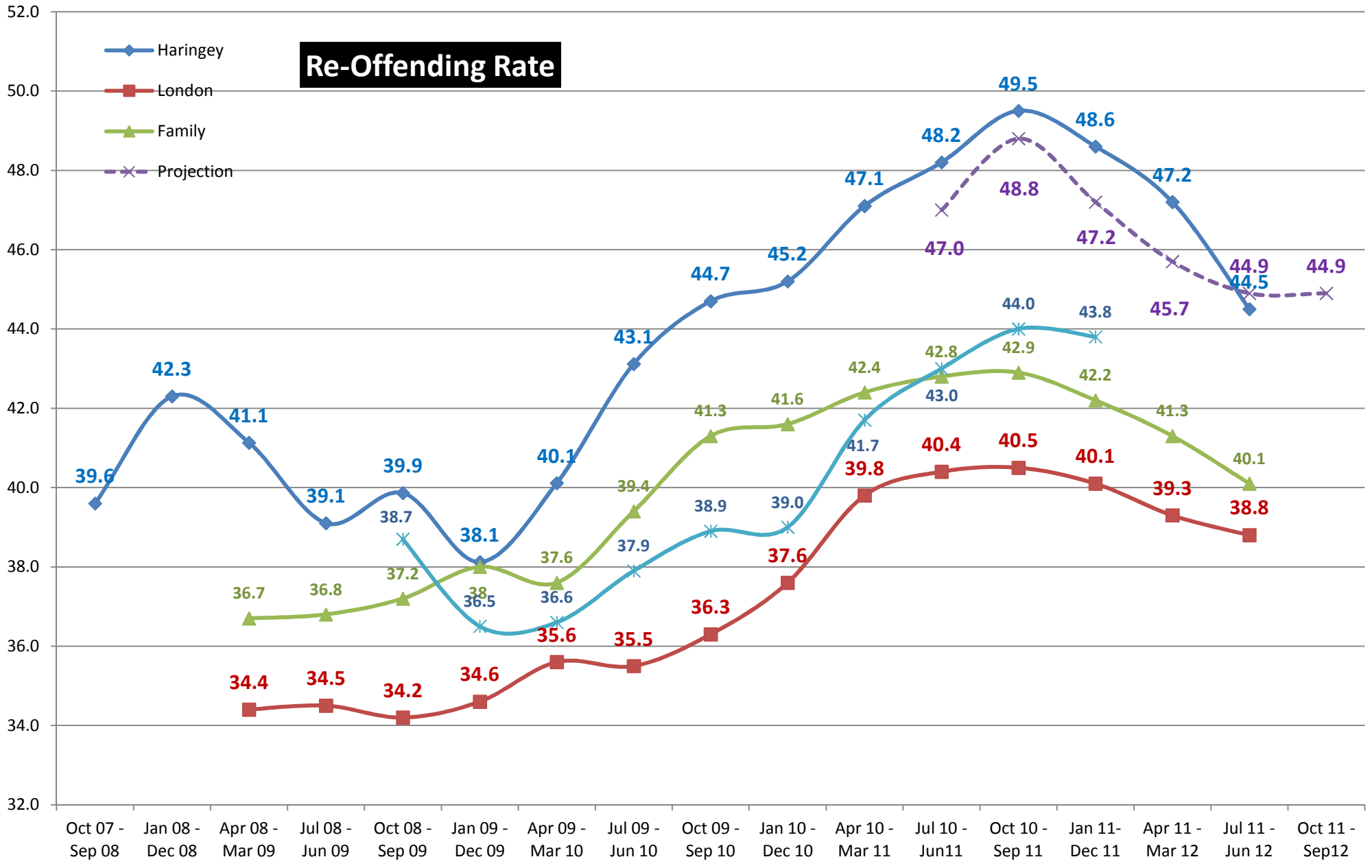
