

## APPENDIX 5

### Adult Social Care Population and Day Care

For the period April - September 2014 there were **2604** people over 65 in receipt of Adult Social Care Services. **1997** of these people were in the Community – the remainder being in residential and nursing care. **270** people were in receipt of Day Care.

The Community Services breakdown for over 65's is as follows. This shows the amount of service delivered and individuals may be in receipt of more than one service.
