
Population projections for those aged 65 yrs and above 2008-2025

















The Referrals, Assessments and Packages of Care Project (RAP) was developed to provide a coherent set of national statistics on adult community care, purchased or provided by Councils with Social Services Responsibilities (CSSRs).


The 2005-06 RAP figures have been applied to the ONS 2005 mid-year population estimates of the 65 and over population, to give estimated projections of the numbers predicted to receive community-based services provided or commissioned by the CSSR, to 2025.
