

OPTION APPRAISAL CRITERIA

Pre Qualification Questions: If options do not meet these questions, they do not go onto full appraisal.

Answer Y/N

- 1) Able to accommodate appropriate practice size.
- 2) Value for Money (to the best of knowledge at time of scoring).
- 3) Fit for Purpose (according to NHS Standards i.e disabled access, room sizes, appropriate IT).
- 4) Able to get suitable planning permission.

Options Appraisal

Weight each criterion 1 – 3

- 3 – High
- 2 – Medium
- 1 – Low

Accessibility

- 1) Accessible for required population – within a 15 min walk or a 5 or more in a PTAL1 assessment
- 2) Is it accessible 08:00 – 20:00 7 days a week
- 3) Potential for disabled parking

Design

- 4) Flexibility of design to meet future needs

Deliverability

- 5) Available at the right time

Strategic Fit

- 6) Able to integrate with other community services
