- 1. Describe the issue under consideration
- 1.1 This report relates to an application for the Review of Olympus Nightclub Premises License by Mark Greaves Police Licensing Officer, under 'The Prevention of Crime and Disorder 'licensing objective.
- 1.2 Summary of review received:
 - i) An application has been received from the Metropolitan Police as a Responsible Authority under the Licensing Act 2003 for a review of the premises licence at Olympus on the grounds of "The Prevention of Crime and Disorder' following a numer of public disorder outbreaks at the premises. The Police Licensing Officers view is that the following factors show the premises is not complying with the licensing act objectives and the conditions of the licence:
 - Mr Alma has permitted the premises to be used by outside promoters which has led to customers fighting in the street which has impacted on residents and those in the High Road at the time.
 - As a requirement of promoting the objective of 'The Prevention of Crime and Disorder' the licence was conditioned to not allow for external promotions/event and DJs to be used at the premises.
