

The Director of Public Health agreed to waive the requirement to tender and award a contract for £10,000 for one year commencing February 2016 to A-Life for the delivery of a physical activity and nutrition programme in schools - 3 Feb. 2016	2
The Director of Public Health agreed funding for the SHINE Enterprise centre. The contract will run from 1 <sup>st</sup> April 2015 to 31 <sup>st</sup> March 2016. The value of the contract will be 20k - 3 Feb. 2016	3
The Director of Public Health agreed to award a contract to Fruition to design and deliver a level 3 accredited train the trainers Speakeasy course. The contract will run from February 2016 to 31 <sup>th</sup> April 2016. The maximum value will be £20,000 - 17 Feb. 2016	4
The Director of Public Health agreed to an extension of contract for the Safer London Foundation for the delivery of training in Haringey, in support of the CSE prevention programme in schools.
