1.Describe the issue under consideration

1.1 To approve the appointments procedure and to appoint Committees, Sub Committees and appointment of Chairs and once agreed to make such appointments.

3.Recommendations

- 3.1 The recommendations are as follows:
 - 1. That the process for appointing to the Committees, Sub Committees and Chairs be approved on the "slate" basis.
 - 2. That the membership of Committees, Sub Committees and appointment of Chairs be agreed as attached at Appendix 1.
 - 3. That the membership of the Cabinet be noted as attached at Appendix 2.

4.Background information

- 4.1 The Annual Meeting appoints Committees of the Council in accordance with Article 4.02 of the Constitution. Wherever possible bodies have been constituted in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations 1990 in terms of political balance. The proportionality split is as follows: Labour Councillors [48] constitute 84.21% of the available seats on the Council; Liberal Democrat Councillors [9] occupy 15.79%. Where practicable the allocation of seats on Committees should be in line with the proportion of seats on the Council held by the political groups. The rule about proportionate allocation on bodies overall takes precedence over the rule about proportionate allocation on any individual body.
- 4.2 In calculating the allocation of seats on Committees, the following bodies were excluded because they are excluded from the statutory rules on political balance:
 - The disciplinary pool:
 - Licensing Sub-Committees;



- Other Committees where membership is determined on the basis of electoral ward represented:
- · Health and Wellbeing Board; and
- Pensions Board.
- 4.3 The number of seats currently available on ordinary Committees is 52. Of this number 43 or 83% are allocated to the Labour Group and 9 or 17 % to the Liberal Democrat Group.
- 4.4. In view of the volume of appointments to be made it is expedient to approve the appointments on a "slate" basis, rather than on an individual basis.
- 4.5 Changes to appointments can be made at any stage during the Municipal Year with the changes being reported to the Council as appropriate.
- 5. Comments of the Assistant Director Corporate Governance & Monitoring Officer
- 5.1 The report sets out those Council bodies to which the political balance rules apply. The 1989 Act requires political balance in the distribution of seats on committees to be undertaken "so far as is reasonably practicable" thus recognising that a mathematically precise split between political parties cannot always be achieved.
- 5.2 The rules in section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 require that a party with a majority on full Council shall have a majority of seats on each non-executive body and this rule takes precedence over the rules requiring an exact political balance on those bodies individually and taken as a whole.
