

Proposed Public Space Protection Order (PSPO): Love Lane Estate

1. Introduction

In March 2018 Haringey’s Community Safety and Regulatory Services initiated a consultation on the proposed introduction of a PSPO to ban defined criminal and antisocial activities within the Love Lane Estate located between White Hart Lane and Whitehall Street N17. The area also includes William Street, Moselle Street, Moselle Place, and the flats on Whitehall Street

PSPOs are designed to provide a solution to the problems of crime and antisocial behaviour (ASB) that now affect much of North Tottenham.

The most recent North Tottenham Perceptions Survey carried out by the council in December 2017 confirms that criminal and ASB are now seen as severe problems by residents. Many residents consider that the streets are no longer safe after dark – a problem made worse by what they report as an absence of visible policing in Tottenham.

2. Demographics of Respondents

85 responses have been received from a delivery area of 500 properties. This represents a 17% response rate which is very satisfactory for a part of the borough where engagement can be difficult.
